RECOGNIZING ADMETECH FOUNDATION AS THE HOST OF THE SECOND ANNUAL PROSTATE CANCER AWARENESS DAY AT THE MASSACHUSETTS STATE HOUSE ON JUNE 16, 2010.

WHEREAS, PROSTATE CANCER IS THE MOST COMMON MAJOR CANCER IN THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA AND AFFECTS 1 IN 6 MEN; AND

WHEREAS, A MAN IS NEWLY DIAGNOSED WITH PROSTATE CANCER EVERY 2 1/2 MINUTES; AND

WHEREAS, A MAN WILL DIE EVERY 19 MINUTES FROM PROSTATE CANCER, THE SECOND MOST LETHAL FORM OF CANCER IN MEN; AND

WHEREAS, MEN IN THE COMMONWEALTH ARE AT THE SECOND HIGHEST RISK OF DEVELOPING AND DYING OF PROSTATE CANCER IN THE UNITED STATES, AND EARLY DETECTION AND TREATMENT REMAIN THE GREATEST DEFENSES AGAINST THIS DISEASE; AND

WHEREAS, THE ADMETECH FOUNDATION, IN COLLABORATION WITH US TOO INTERNATIONAL, THE PROSTATE HEALTH EDUCATION NETWORK AND THE MASSACHUSETTS PROSTATE CANCER COALITION, REMAINS COMMITTED TO WORKING TOWARDS ENDING THE PROSTATE CANCER CRISIS BY INCREASING EDUCATION, RESEARCH AND AWARENESS TO IMPROVE EARLY DETECTION AND SAVE LIVES; AND

WHEREAS, PROSTATE CANCER AWARENESS DAY IS BEING CELEBRATED ON JUNE 16, 2010, CONCURRENT WITH FATHER'S DAY AND MEN'S HEALTH MONTH; NOW THEREFORE BE IT
